Organizations face growing identity challenges

67% of respondents reported an increase in identity-related incidents over the past 3 years

Detection is lagging

55% of organizations have immature identity protection

53% say it takes them hours to detect identity-based security incidents

20% are not detecting identity-related threats until data exfiltration

Financial impacts of identity-related attacks are real



Nearly 1/3 of respondents reported financial consequences of **\$100,000** or more



Over half (51%) of respondents reported at least **\$50,000** in losses

98% of organizations are allotting more money for identity protection compared to last year
